I have today made a careful examination and inspection of every part of the building and find it complete in full accordance with the terms of the contract on the plans and specifications. The main contractor, the Paterson Construction Company and all of the separate contracts entering into the main contract have done one of the most satisfactory pieces work that I have ever had done and I have congratulated them all, both on your behalf as well as my own, for their splendid cooperation. As for the people of North Branford, I can only tell you what you alread know, and that is that their feeling of appreciation, enjoyment and gratitude for your gift to them, knows no bounds. It seems as if every inhabitant in the town has stopped me at one time or another during the past nine months of the construction and expressed these sentiments heartily.

The writer is extremely grateful for the privilege of having served you in this connection, and offers to you the best wishes of himself and entire family for your happiness and health.
